Environmental Policy Statement

Mallatite recognises its responsibility for protecting and preserving the environment. Our dealings with the general public, customers, employees, regulators, and neighbours reflect our commitment to environmental improvement and respect for the sustainability of our natural resources.

The Company is committed to operating its businesses in accordance with all applicable environmental legislation and other relevant requirements.

We conduct our activities within the framework of working for a safe world under the following guiding principles and currently subscribe to limit and manage its environmental outputs.

The site processes steel tubes into lighting columns by sawing, swaging, plasma cutting and welding then galvanised and finally finishing in single or two pack paint, bitumen or thermoplastic.

Mallatite will environmentally manage its activities to minimise any potential impact 'so far as is reasonably practicable'. We will actively encourage all of our employees and take the lead in promoting environmental best practice.

We will monitor our outputs and emissions to best practice standards, in accordance with ISO14001 requirements, where improvements are required we will aim to achieve within the shortest possible timescale.

Our Environmental Policy has full company support at all levels to ensure that we will:

- Audit and appraise regularly to ensure best practice.
- Monitor our activities to ensure our emissions are eliminated, effectively controlled or reduced to meet or exceed regulatory requirements.
- Reduce our waste to the lowest practicable level. We will dispose in a responsible manner. Measuring the results and aim to reduce each subsequent audit period.
- Involve employees in our environmental program encouraging full participation including training in sustainability and reduced output of waste or process.
- Adopt the process of BATNEEC (Best Available Techniques Not Entailing EXCESSIVE Costs).
- Require contractors to also comply with this policy where practicable.
- Source our products from like minded organisations who will, as far as is reasonably practicable, adopt the same policy as ourselves.
- Review this policy if new techniques become available or if legislation changes that affects our undertaking.
